In Science, the children will be learning about Earth and Space. We have already set the children some homework where we would like them to observe the moon over a 28 day cycle.

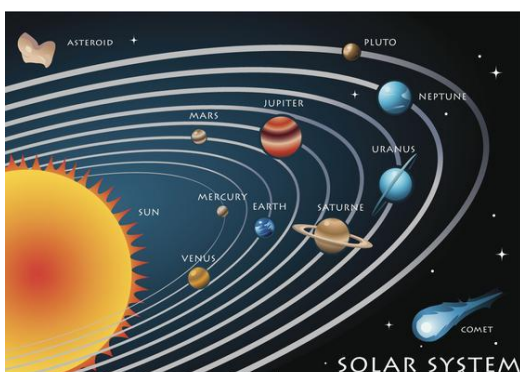
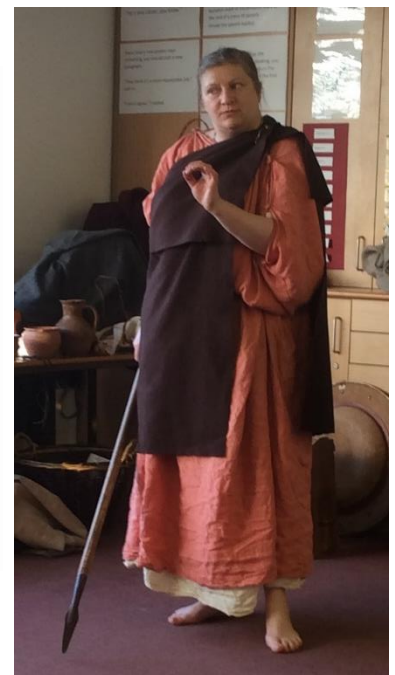
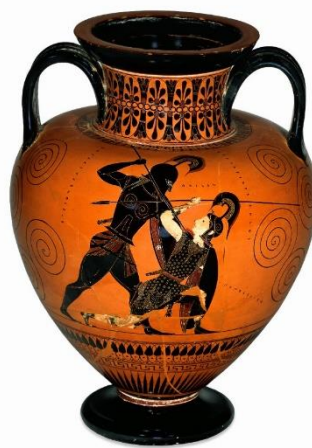
