I'm special, I'm me!

Our Topic

This half-term our context for learning is 'I'm special, I'm me!' Children will take part in a range of activities to further their understanding of their body (comparing it to animals), their senses, family and the things they like and dislike. We will talk about how they keep healthy and look at how they have changed and grown over time.



English

Daily stories will link to our theme and encourage children to develop their listening skills and share their understanding of the books. Children will visit the library this half term so they can choose books for us to read together in class. Children will continue to practise pencil grip, letter formation and constructing sentences. This term children will be learning and working with phase 2 sounds in phonics in both writing and reading.

Mathematics

Children will be working on recognising and using numbers up to 20 including counting on and back, matching the number of objects to an amount, ordering and writing numbers. Some children will be completing simple addition and subtraction sums.

P.E.

In PE, children will be practising a range of skills such as throwing and catching as well
