Out in the Wilds

Year 4 will escape the classroom this Autumn and be outside in all weathers for our 'Out in the Wilds' topic.



Every Thursday afternoon, we will brave the great outdoors but we will first teach the children how to dress correctly for all weathers. Activities will cover most curriculum subjects and our finale celebration will be 'Wild Country Week' where children will learn bushcraft skills and outdoor survival. English

Our focus throughout Year 4 will be to encourage writing stamina and develop positive attitudes towards writing. To begin with, children will learn a range of new sentence types and practise their use of paragraphs.

<u>Maths</u>

We're off to a good start with securing our understanding of number skills and place value. We are also looking at the formal written methods for $+ - x \div$.

As ever, we remain focussed on our aim of the children knowing their times



tables up to 12 X 12 by the end of year 4 so please continue to support your child to learn them at home too.

<u>Science</u>

Our Science topic this half term is 'Living things and their habitats'

which we will cover through our work in 'Out in the Wilds'. Children need to know the life processes which all living things demonstrate, 'MRS GREN' will help them with this. Ask your child about her in a few weeks time!

<u>Spellings</u>

Spellings are tested on Wednesdays

and new spellings taught in school on Thursdays. We will follow the Year 4 'Spell Zoo' programme



where we will find word lists based on homophones and a

variety of prefixes and suffixes.

Reading Records

We expect children to read at least

three times per week at home. Reading books can be changed on **any day** and reading records are checked on Thursdays

for evidence of reading. Y4 will change their library books on Friday afternoons.

Homework

Homework will continue to be collected in on Thursdays and new homework set. If any spare copies are required



they are available for children to collect in a 'spares' tray.

PE

Our regular PE day is **Tuesday**.

Children will wear their PE kit which has been provided by school.
