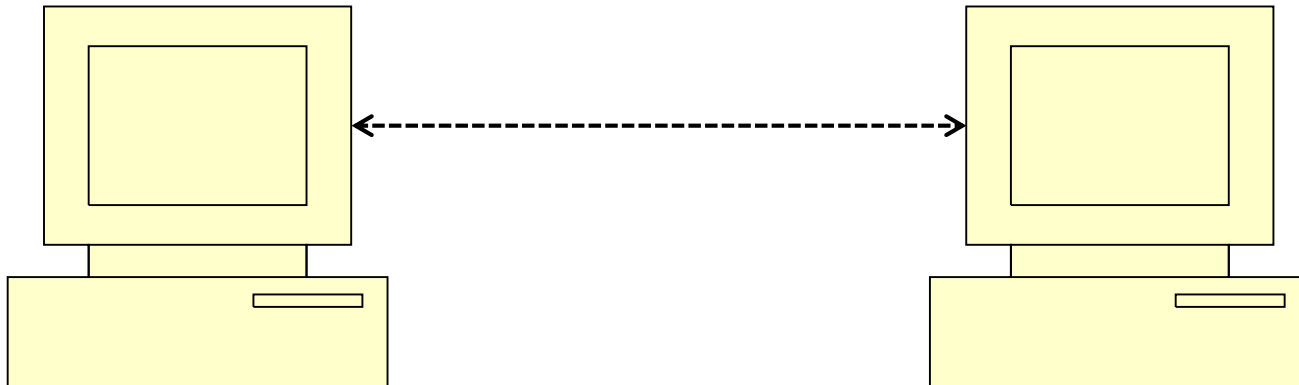


What is the Internet?



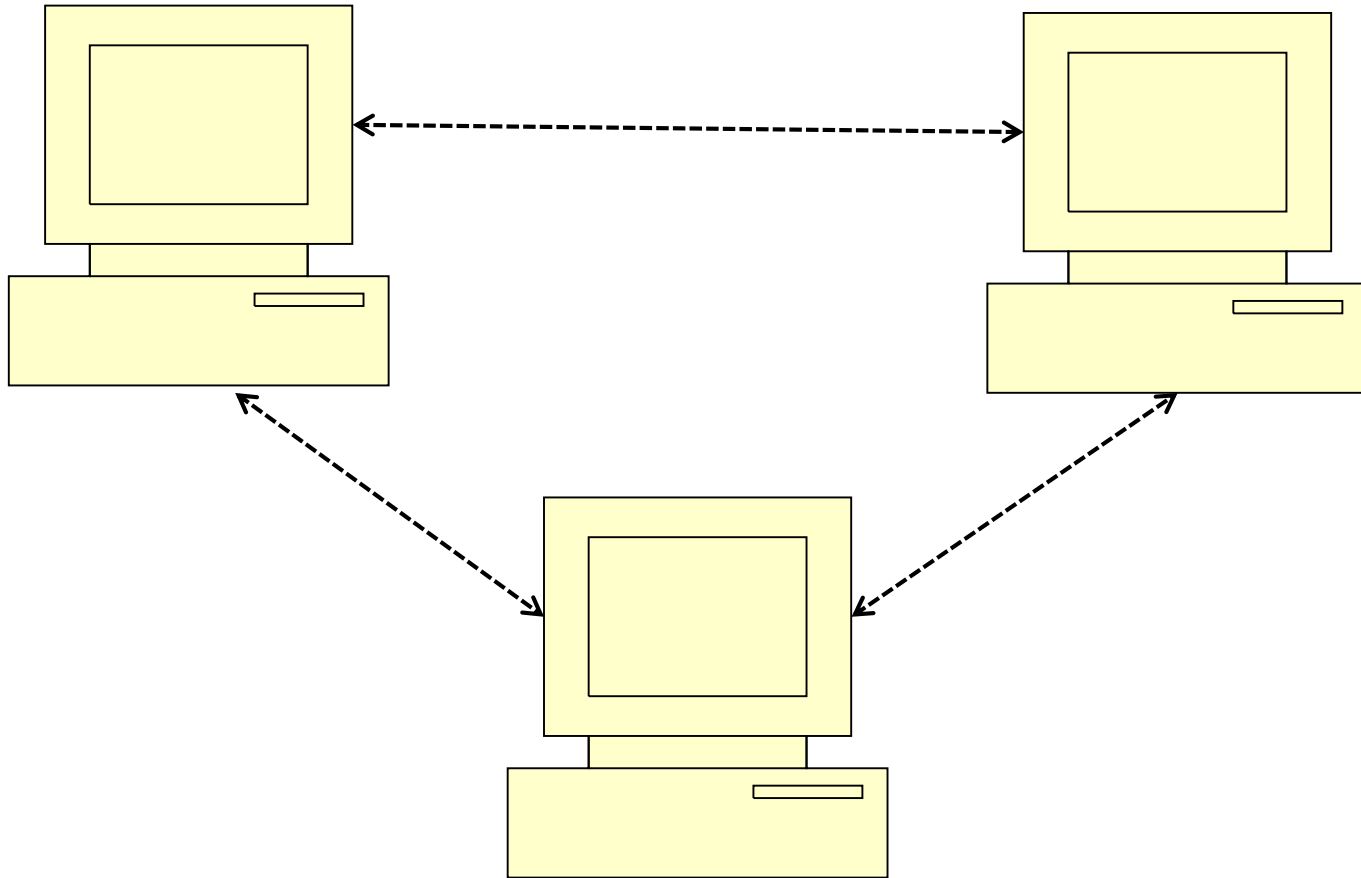

The beginning

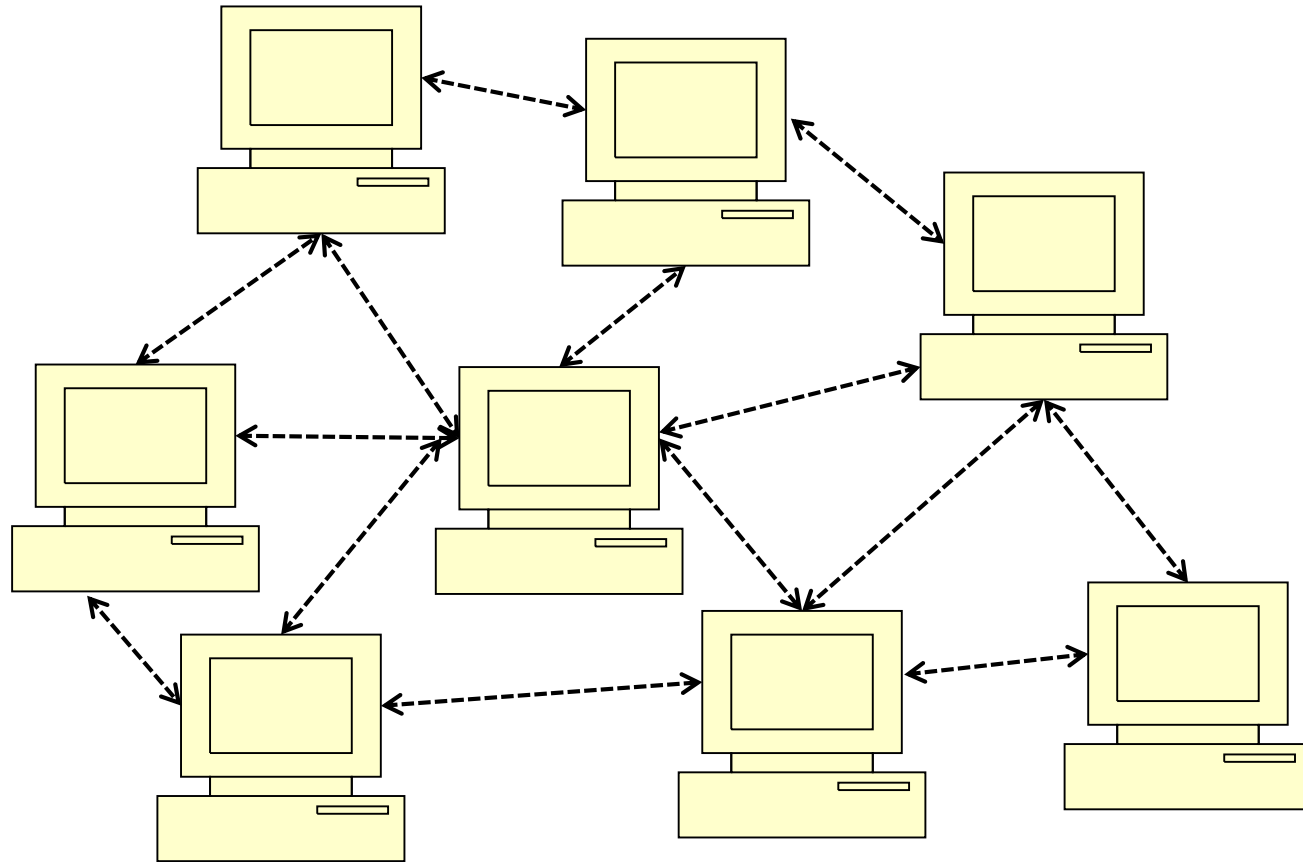


The Internet began when two supercomputers were connected as a network. This happened in the US as part of a 1960s defence project called ARPANET using a new technology called Packet Switching.

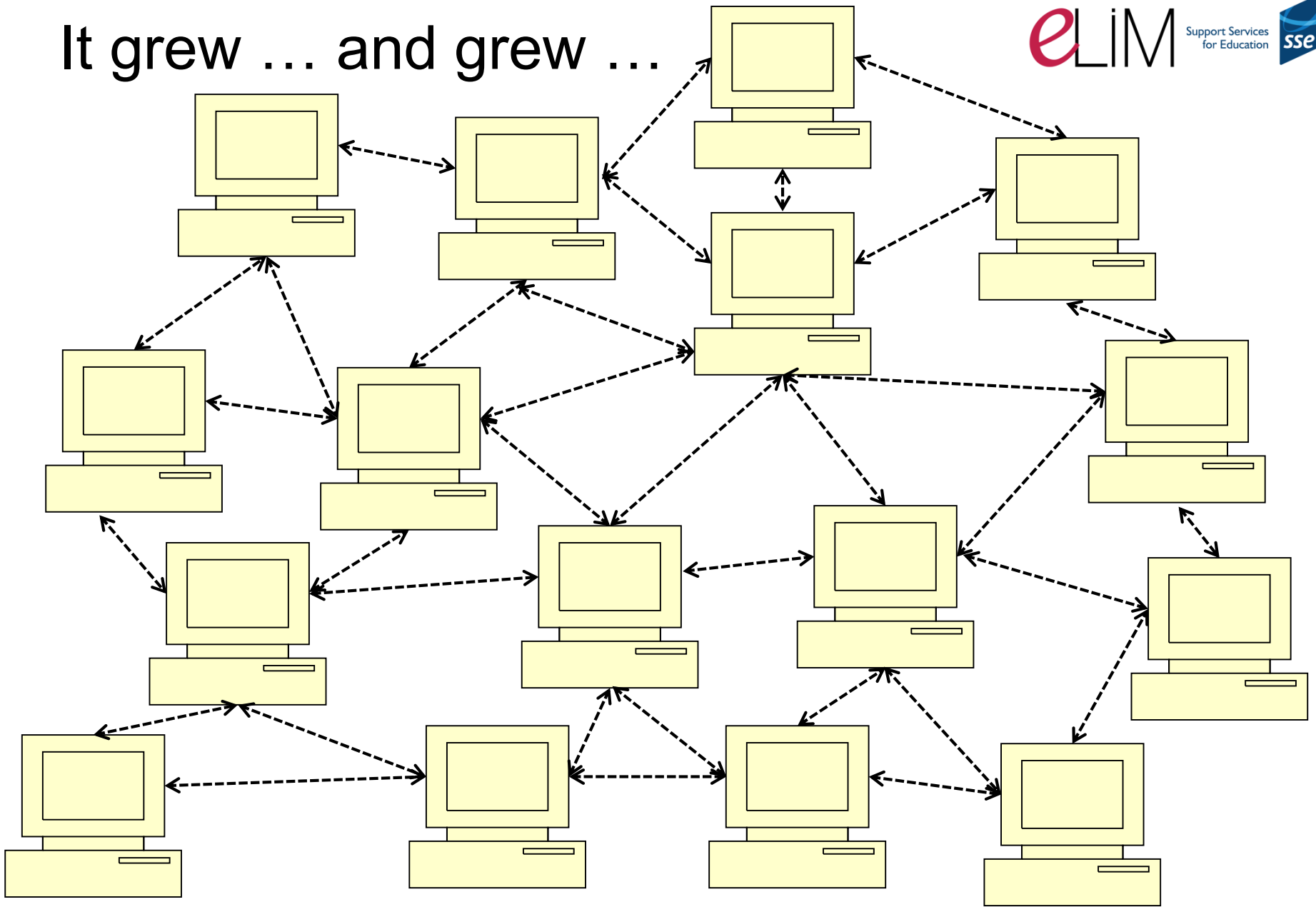

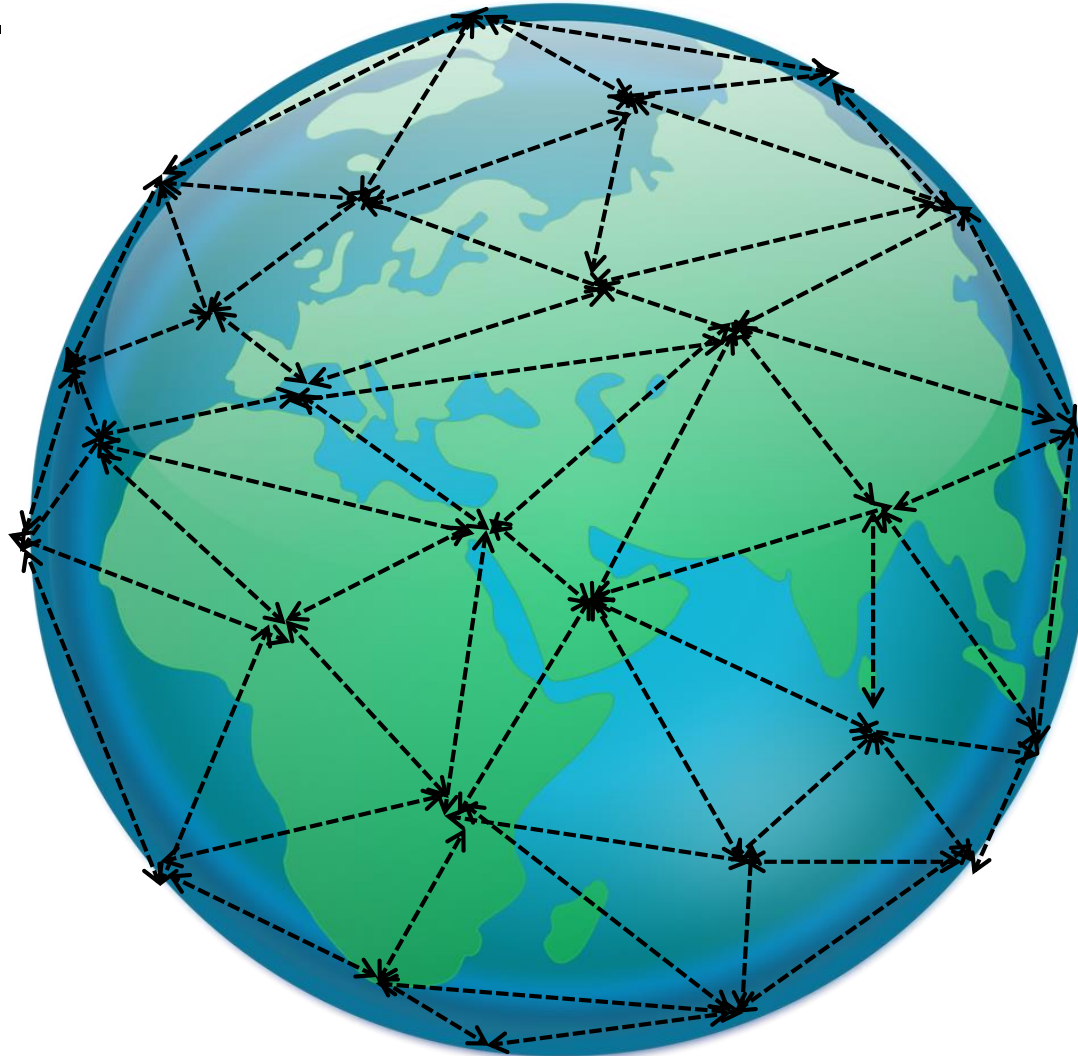
Devices changed over time...



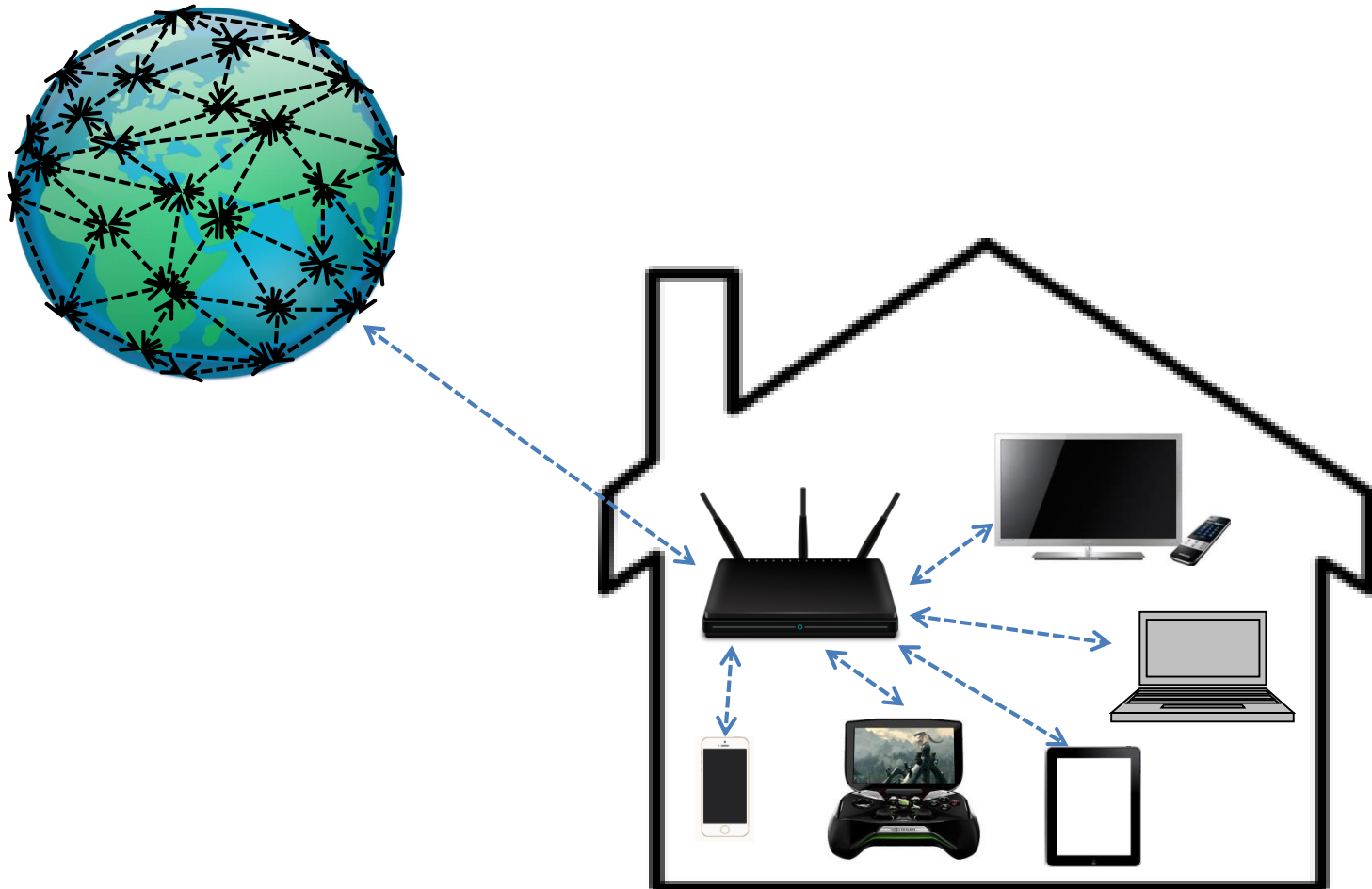
And changed again...



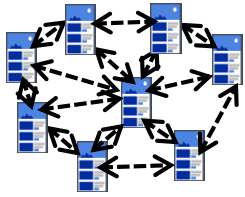
The Internet is a network that continues to grow and joins up devices all over the world.
