


Tommy bakes 2 birthday cakes for a party.  
He cuts each cake into 8 pieces.  
5 pieces are eaten from the first cake and 7  
pieces from the second.



Tommy

There is half a cake left.

True

$$1 - \frac{5}{8} = \frac{3}{8}$$

First cake.

$$1 - \frac{7}{8} = \frac{1}{8}$$

Second cake.

$$\frac{3}{8} + \frac{1}{8} = \frac{4}{8}$$

Left over cake.
