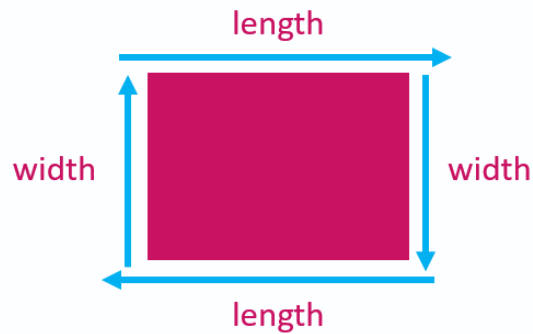


How to Measure the Perimeter of a Rectangle

We use the **length** and **width** measurements of a rectangle to calculate the perimeter of a rectangle.

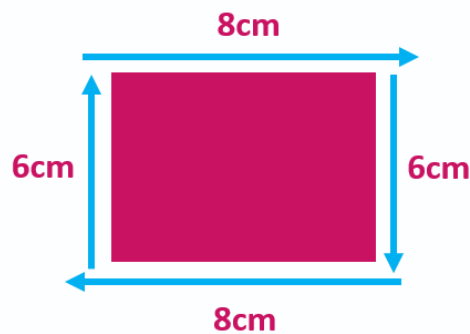


We simply add up all the length and width measurements to find the perimeter of something.



Another way of thinking about how to calculate the perimeter of a rectangle is:

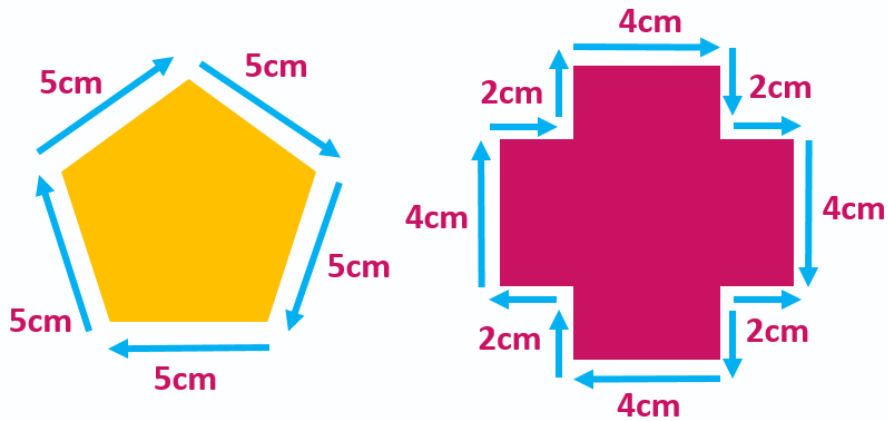
$$\text{Perimeter} = 2 \times \text{length} + 2 \times \text{width}$$



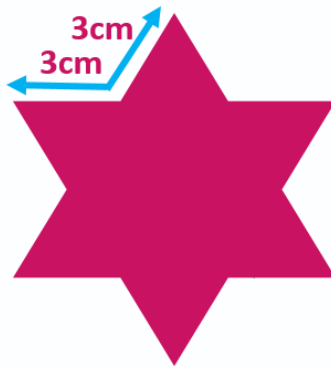
Work out the perimeter of this rectangle.

Sometimes, we don't need to measure every side of the shape. Especially when the shape is symmetrical
