Maths Homework:

The children have been given a new Maths Homework book. We would like children to complete pages 17 to 28 and focus on measurements. Any practise cooking and measuring that can be done at home would be fantastic!

The trick with this homework is little and often! We don't want anyone panicking on Easter Monday night! Homework is due in on Friday 26th April.
